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We are Specialist Nurses who work as part of the Colorectal Team. We specialise mainly in cancers of the colon and rectum. Our main role is to co-ordinate the care and treatment you receive whilst being treated at the West Suffolk Hospital.

If you require treatment at another centre it is our role to liaise with them and to ensure good communications between all departments. We will also liaise closely with your GP and community staff as appropriate.

What do we do?

- Provide appropriate information about treatments/investigations and their sideeffects.
- Follow you through your journey whilst being treated at the hospitals, and at home.
- Provide advice and support to you and your family and carers.
- Enable you to make choices and decisions on your treatment with you and your family.
- Attend outpatient's clinics and other departments when you visit the hospital.
- Work closely with other health care professionals acting as a support/information resource for them.
- We provide written information tailored to your treatment pathway.
- We co-ordinate your follow-up and surveillance following treatment.
- We work Monday to Friday, office hours, and are contactable by telephone.
- Our office is in F5/6 corridor. If you are in the hospital and would like to see us please feel free to come and find us.
