ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS FOR SHOE LACES

Elasticated shoe laces- help the child by preventing the need for tying and retying shoelaces - shoes can be slipped on and off.



Coil Shoe Laces - Once in place, just pull to tighten and the elastic coil keep shoes secure. Coilers are available in a variety of bright, fun colours.



Lock Laces Elastic Shoelaces- are elastic shoelaces with a locking system with a spring activated locking device. Just loosen to release and pull to tighten.



GREEPER®- Laces are loosened by pulling on the pull tab of the central toggle, but cannot come undone remaining "always tied". The laces are then tightened by pulling on each lace loop at the point where the special stopper is located. Available in different colours.
