We have looked carefully at all the feedback. Thank you.

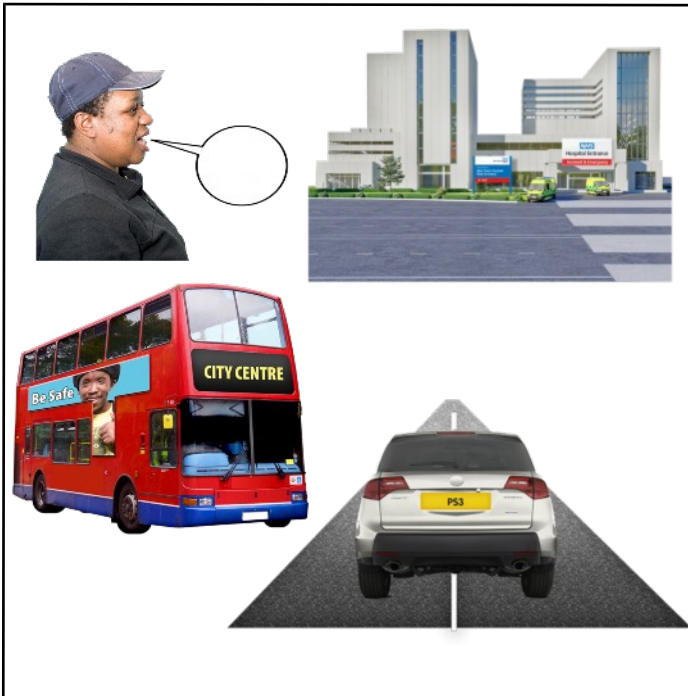


## What happens next?

The next thing we need to do is apply for outline planning permission.

That means we will ask the Local Planning Authority at West Suffolk Council if they will agree to the hospital being built at Hardwick Manor.

We will need to give them a lot of information to help them decide.



For example, we will have to let the Council know things like:

- how many buildings there would be
- how big those buildings are
- and the roads people will need to use to get there by car or public transport

If the council agrees to our plan we will be one step nearer to building our new hospital.

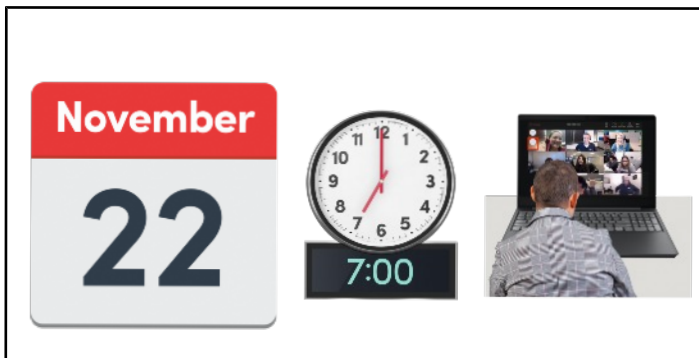

**What are the meetings about?**

The meetings are your chance to have a look at the plans and say what you think.

We will listen to what everyone has to say.

- a member of your family
- a friend or a neighbour

**What happens next?**

There are a lot of things that need to be done.

By early 2022 we will have looked at all the feedback, got all the documents ready and we will send them to the Local Planning Authority at West Suffolk Council.



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By summer 2022 the Local Planning Authority at West Suffolk Council will let us know what they have decided about the plans.

They will let us know if we can build the new hospital or if anything needs to be changed.

We will keep everyone up to date about how the plans are going.

Don't forget you can ask someone you trust for help to complete the feedback form.



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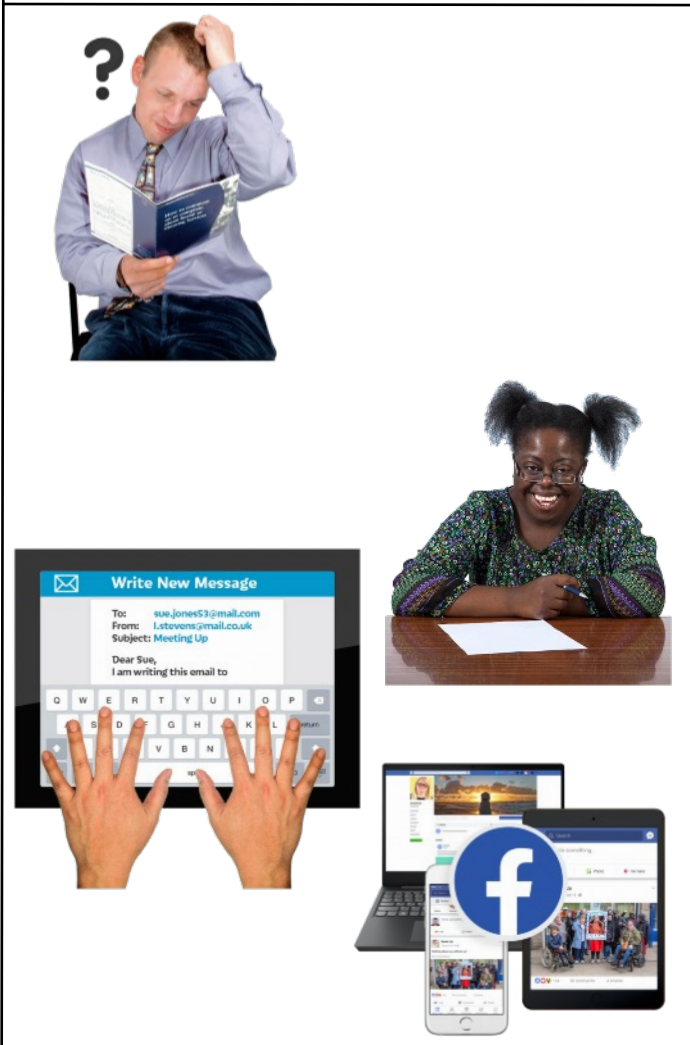
### What do I need to do with my Feedback Form?
