

West Suffolk Community Cardiac Rehabilitation Service Referral Guidelines

Inclusion Criteria: Diagnosis within the last 3 months of:

- ACS: STEMI / NSTEMI / PCi / PPCi / Stable Angina / SCAD
- Cardiac Surgery: CABG / Valve Surgery / Other Cardiothoracic
- Stable Heart Failure & Cardiomyopathies
- Congenital
- Heart Transplant
- ICD / LVAD AND CRT

Service Provided

<u>Initial Telephone Call</u>: Identification of individual needs and arrangement of assessment within 3 working days of receipt of referral.

<u>Initial Assessment</u>: Cardiac Nurse-led assessment, identification of risk factors, medication review, setting of personal goals, arrangement of exercise assessment.

We also offer a facilitated self-management Cardiac Rehabilitation programme using the Heart Manual for patients who may prefer this approach. More information about the Heart Manual can be found on the website: <u>www.theheartmanual.com</u>.

- Newmarket Newmarket Community Hospital
- Sudbury Sudbury Community Health Centre
- Haverhill Haverhill Health Centre
- Home Visits for eligible Cardiac Rehab referrals

<u>Exercise Assessment</u>: Assessment of individual's fitness prior to commencement of their programme, this is repeated on completion.

Exercise and Education Programme: Group or Home based programmes available.

- Sudbury Community Health Centre including Lower Intensity Group
